Dear Parents,

As part of our Science topic and with links to English, we have arranged for Year 1 and year 2 to visit Imagine That Liverpool on Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> April 2023. The visit will reinforce the children's learning in class and involve going around the activities in the museum and attending engaging learning sessions.

The visit will require a contribution of £16.00, per child, to cover all the costs of entry and the coach. This can be paid via parent pay and can be paid in instalments with the final payment being due by  $1^{st}$  March 2023.

Due to the distance travelling, the visit will be longer than the regular school day. Please can we ask that children are at school for 8.15am, which will be when we open the gates as normal. We will return to school for a 4pm collection, collecting the children from the classroom doors as usual. Children will wear their school uniform (including their school jumper/cardigan with our school badge for easy identification) and school shoes. Please ensure they have a water bottle with them on the day.

As Year 1 and Year 2 children can have a free school meal, our kitchen is able to provide them with a packed lunch. Closer to the time, I will ask the children what filling they would like on their sandwich. The packed lunch comes with a drink, a piece of fruit and either a biscuit or a cake.

If your child is asthmatic and they do not have an inhaler in school, please send one in with their name on.

Any concerns at all, please come and talk to us and we will see how we can help.
